Library roof leaking. \$1,000,000.00 to close down the Pender Harbor landfill. 3 Gambier Island Bridges need fixing. 50% of dock cost for repairs born by Area F. Ian this is untenable. Must go back to square 1 and look at port function and funding model. Outsource maintenance or divest to Squamish Nation.
