Gibsons and District Fire Department Annual dinner. All 10 new 2016 recruit have made it through training. Twin Creeks OCP review committee met last week and 2017 will have monthly meetings to move the review along. Area F is unique in	

the SCRD as it has 3 separate OCPs. Federal Ocean Protection Plan has \$1.5 billion of funding and what will the SCRD/Howe Sound get in light of LNG project. Granthams Hall grants options include Federal Canada Cultural Spaces Fund and BC Rural dividend Fund. MP can help navigate grants process. Police Advisory Committee does not have a resident from WHS to advocate local policing issues including road safety, crime with Lorne Lewis as chair. Howe Sound Community Forum was attended by full SCRD Board and heard presentation about Howe Sound Biosphere process which can take 10-15 year. Clayquot Sound and Mt Arrowsmith have the Biosphere Reserve Status. Ian attending AVICC solid waste committee on Vancouver Island. SCRD landfill lifespan is 15 years. Solutions are need to prevent the expense of shipping waste by barge to Washington State as happens with Powell River. SCRD budget process beginning with presentations from 20 stakeholder groups which receive funding. New procedures for accountability and transparency. SCRD organizational changes continue. Board directs CAO to make SCRD more effective and to keep minimize tax increases. Local government reorganizations are minor compared with frequency and scope which occurs in the private sector.
