- 1. Call to order; 7:30pm, agenda adopted.
- 2. Minutes from March 2013 directors meeting adopted (with change noting that JKenly wrote to SCRD, rather than AAC; minutes from April general meeting reviewed)..
- 3. Reports
 - 1. Treasurer's report: Bank balance is \$906.11.
- 4. Business
 - 1. Advertising, promotions. Discussion about whether we should have a Facebook page but no decision
 - 2. Bookings for meetings must be done in July. Agreed to book as per usual: October, February, April and June. Try for 7pm 9pm.
 - 3. Transit, no development
 - 4. Decision to spend \$25 for a booth at the Synchronicity Festival
 - 5. Granthams Wharf. Discussion about wrapping pilings with landscaping material to encourage herring spawn. Wharf work being done during May long weekend
 - 6. Burnco. Concern expressed about cumulative effects on land and marine environment; JValeriote agrees to gather general information for consideration of members at June 12 general meeting
 - 7. Transportation. MHiltz mentions progress that has been made in pressing Don Legault to order road repairs; LTurnbull said she is trying to get no-parking signs near ferry terminal to stop drivers from leaving vehicles along the highway; MHiltz will investigate complaints about BC Ferries lights shining into two nearby homes; MHiltz will check on status of bike racks.
 - 8. Marine Drive plan. LTurnbull says SCRD planning to spend \$100,000 this year on bike path between Soames and the ferry terminal. JValeriote asks about consultations with residents and agrees to work with LTurnbull on this.
 - 9. Langdale School. Talks about GIA for tennis/basketball court put on ice for the remainder of this year due to disruptions at the school. Another effort will be made next year.
 - 10. Coyotes. Discussion about the growing brazenness of these creatures
 - 11. June 12 general meeting. MHiltz will check on whether conservation officer is available to talk about coyote, bear issues. If not, meeting will be open-mike for discussion about any issues
 - 12. Pulp mill. A resident has raised concerns about pulp mill emissions and potential pollution of soil and water but decision made not to pursue
- 5. SCRD Area F Director Report
 - Plan for water metering in the SCRD within two years, a survey is circulating until May 15; agricultural regulations in the SCRD to be discussed at a meeting with planner Andrew Allan at Chaster House May 22; shoreline parks in Area F; planner David Raphael is doing a report on the Box Canyon hydro electricity project; BC Ferries development plan and its effect on parking lot traffic.
